

Imagine life as a mountain to be climbed... and at the very top of the mountain is our destination... the Kingdom of God.

Imagine the mountain stretching up before us... it rises up so high that we can't see the top, but we know that God is waiting for us up there.

The mountain has three distinct sides, or faces, each representing one of the transcendentals: truth, goodness, and beauty...

and our job is to help students find their unique path,

and once on their way, we encourage them to keep climbing.

There are many paths up the mountain, and it doesn't matter which path a student chooses to take. All that matters is that each student keeps climbing.

Each path offers unique experiences and life lessons, and if the path is chosen with care and prayer, it will be aligned with God's plan for that student.

It will lead the student towards the summit... towards God.

Student Drop and Go Zone

To ensure the maximum safety of our students, please do your part:

Bus Safety

- Listen to instructions given by the bus driver to ensure safety for everyone.
